BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2012-110, AS AMENDED,
BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE OR PROHIBIT SIGNS AND OTHER
ADVERTISING DEVICES

WHEREAS By-law No. 2012-110 was enacted and passed on October 1, 2012, to regulate or prohibit signs and other advertising devices;

AND WHEREAS Council has enacted By-law No. 2025-003, being a by-law to establish and administer a system for administrative monetary penalties in the Town of Collingwood;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to align the enforcement provisions of By-law No. 2013-021, as amended, with the Administrative Monetary Penalty System established under By-law No. 2025-003, to enhance the efficiency, fairness, and accessibility of by-law enforcement in the Town of Collingwood;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** Part 39.0 titled "Penalty for Non-Compliance" of By-law No. 2012-110, as amended, is hereby amended to add the following sections:
 - 39.4 The Town's Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law applies to this By-law.
 - 39.5 Every person who contravenes a provision of this By-law shall, upon issuance of a Penalty Notice in accordance with the Town's Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law, be liable to pay to the Town an Administrative Monetary Penalty in the amount specified in the By-law.
 - 39.6 No person that is issued a Penalty Notice under the Town's Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law shall be charged with an offence in respect of the same contravention under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 33, as amended.
2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of final passage hereof at which time all By-laws and/or resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law and the same are hereby repealed or rescinded insofar as it is necessary to give effect to the provisions of this By-law.
